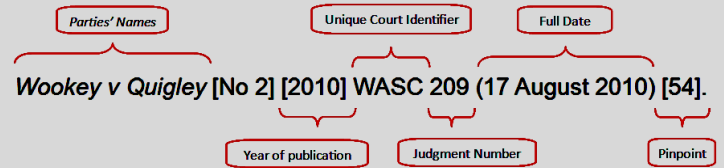
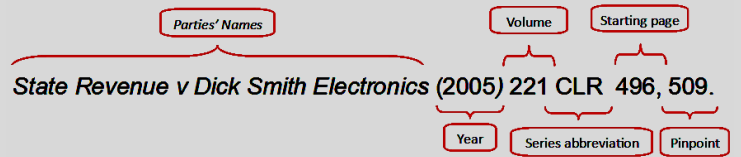

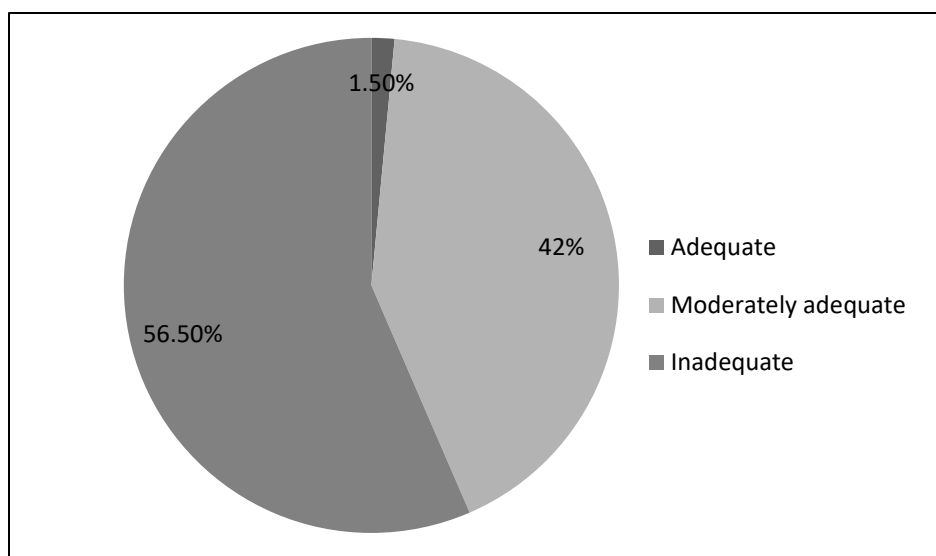


Fig. 1: Distribution of Migraine Patients on Overall Knowledge with Regard to Migraine.
